General Rules

1. Show is open to any person who is under the age of 22 as of January 1, 2011 and a member of the North Carolina Junior Hereford Association. Membership dues are \$10.
2. All animals must be registered with the American Hereford Association. Note: Steers must have a certificate from the American Hereford Association.
3. Polled, horned and scurred cattle will be shown together.
4. **Entries must be postmarked by 5/1/11.** Entry fee is \$10 per head and is non-refundable.

5. All entries may arrive anytime after 8 am on 5/14/2011, but must be in the barn by noon on 5/14/2011. Exhibitors are released after the show.
6. Entries must meet North Carolina health regulations and have health certificates from an accredited veterinarian.
7. Participants will be responsible for **providing their own bedding**, feed, etc. during the show.
8. Original registration certificate and health certificate must be presented at check-in.
9. The final decision on class breaks will be made after all entries are received.
10. The show will start with showmanship. Class breaks will be made after all entries are received.
11. The show will consist of females born on or after September 1, 2009, Cow/calf pairs and steers. Calf in a cow/calf pair cannot be over 9 months of age. Calf is eligible for individual classes, but must be entered for that class.
